### Position Summary:

The Camp Worker positions are geared towards those who are interested in gaining experience working with children aged 5-10 years in a fun, exciting and positive environment. They are responsible for assisting the Summer Camp Counsellors with programs and a variety of small and large group activities each week with a positive, upbeat, and helpful attitude. Activities may include crafts, games, and presentations. They will also be responsible for the general safety and care of the participants in his/her group. While doing so, they are expected to serve as an appropriate role model for the children under their care.

Reports to the Summer Camp Supervisor.

### Responsibilities:

- Assist in the supervision of all aspects of the campers' day and know the whereabouts to ensure campers safety
- Interacting and entertaining campers with games and other activities
- Plan, shop and facilitate activities to campers as assigned
- Assist in meal/snack prep and serving
- Assist in housekeeping duties as requested
- Maintain camp schedule
- Participate in Language and Cultural awareness, teachings that promote the Anishinaabe way of life
- Ensure that the site is kept clean, organized, and free of litter.
- Maintain good public relations and coordination with camper parents/guardians emphasizing safety during activity participation
- Know, enforce, and follow all safety rules and procedures

### Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Desire and ability to work with and support children outdoors
- Implicate a creative mindset and positive impact
- Ability to accept supervision and guidance
- Show examples of sharing, collaboration and helpfulness
- Ability to assist in teaching activities setting good examples of cleanliness, punctuality, sharing clean-up responsibilities, and good sportsmanship.
- Good integrity, character, encouraging attitude, and adaptability
- Enthusiasm, sense of humor patience and self-control
- Strong communication and problem-solving skills, both with children and adults
- Organizational and decision-making skills and can work both independently and in small or large teams
- Ability to leave cell phone behind
- Sensitivity to native culture
